As stated in the Material Event Disclosure made by our Company on 27.05.2025, our subsidiary, Celebi GS Chennai Private Limited ("CGSC"), 100% of whose capital belongs to our company, filed two arbitration applications with a request for interim measures against the Airports Authority of India at the High Court of Judicature at Madras on 26.05.2025 and 27.05.2025 regarding the unjust unilateral termination of the Ground Handling Concession Agreement regarding CGSC's operations in Chennai International Airport due to the cancellation of the security permit of CGSC by the Civil Aviation Security Bureau of the Ministry of Civil Aviation of India on the grounds that it poses a threat to national security.

Should there be any further material developments that may affect the shares of our partnership, our shareholders will be informed accordingly.
