As is known, in the process regarding Halkbank's ongoing criminal case in the USA; the Second Circuit rejected our Bank's common law immunity request on October 22, 2024.

Our Bank's appeal of the Second Circuit's adverse ruling with the Supreme Court of the United States was denied by the Supreme Court on October 6, 2025.

This development does not mean that the legal proceedings are finalized. The process will go forward in its ordinary course, and our Bank will continue to assert all its legal rights.

Furthermore, initiatives to find a legal ground of conciliation within the framework of the understandings between the United States and Türkiye are also ongoing in the positive direction.
